TOUR GUIDELINES & SAFETY TIPS

With more 'After Breakfast Tours' being planned for our members to enjoy in this New Year, it is always a good idea to make sure each of us is made aware, again, of those things we need to know in order to ensure everyone has a memorable and enjoyable experience. The following points need to be taken seriously ... and, perhaps, even copied and placed somewhere inside your "A" as a gentle reminder.

- 1. Begin each day with a full tank of gas.
- 2. Tell the tour leader if an unscheduled stop is necessary.
- 3. Keep the Model A behind you in view at all times.
- 4. Tour leaders are always open to suggestions and will implement, if possible.
- 5. If you need to leave the route, inform the tour leader of your departure.
- 6. Notify the tour leader of any car trouble.
- 7. Do not impede traffic. ALWAYS allow modern cars behind you to pass and leave room for traffic to pull in.
- 8. If you will be late, contact the tour leader.
- 9. If you have trouble, pull over and stop in a safe area.

NOTE: only 2-3 support members with mechanical capabilities should stop. All others should continue on with the group.

- 10. While driving in rain or low visibility, turn on your headlights.
- 11. Never stop or pull over in an unsafe area.
- 12. Members driving modern cars should drive at the tail end of the Model A's.
- 13. Separate a large tour group into 2 or 3 mini-groups. We may separate into groups, depending on the route. If this is needed, we will communicate prior to departure. The first group may leave 10 minutes before the next group, etc.




