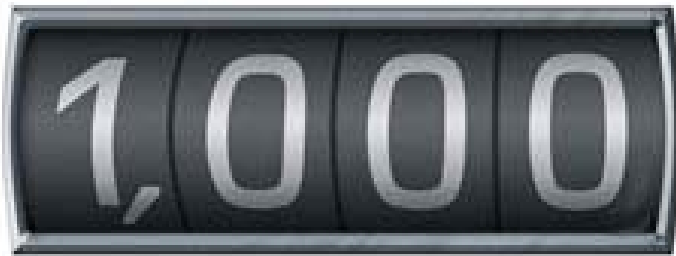
1000 MILE CLUB
