November 1 breakfast will be at Apple Barrel Cafe in Owasso, 14002 E. 116th St. N., corner of 169 and 20 East.



Finer Points by Chris DuVall



Believe it or not, I'm still admiring the goodies we found at Model "A" Days at the Gilmore. It is amazing what you can find at a truly good swap meet. Below is one of my favorites: a grey hound hood ornament affixed to a '30-31 cap!



Even though there are photos of early 1928 cars with grey hound hood ornaments attached, the judging standards do not list this as a Ford authorized accessory. So, what about an authorized accessory? In a previous article, we covered the differences in original quails. So, why don't we take a look at tire gauges. Below is a nice original tire gauge still in its original box. Gauges like these were made for a wide variety of companies, but Ford gauges specify the Ford Model "A".



Isn't that brightly colored box and suede case cool? Although still in the box, the case is not complete. It is missing a tag. Below is a photo of another gauge with the original tag still attached. The tag reads, "This Tire Pressure Gauge, like all precision instruments is designed to measure air pressures accurately; and in order that it keep its efficiency it should not be

dropped or thrown about. When not in use it should be kept separate from other tools preferably in the side pockets of the doors. If not abused, it will last indefinitely." This tag is exceedingly rare today.




So, what do the actual gauges look like? Lucky for you, I have a photo of both styles. The only real difference is in the pointer: the 1928 version has a circle end while the 1929-1931 version has a blunt end.

Since these both still work, maybe the tag claiming they could last indefinitely might not have been far from the truth!





Did You Know??

In 1939, the last Thursday in November fell on the last day of the month. Concerned that the shortened holiday shopping season might dampen the nation's economic recovery from the Great Depression, President Franklin D. Roosevelt issued a Presidential Proclamation moving Thanksgiving to the second to last Thursday of November. Sixteen states refused to accept the change, and for the next two years Thanksgiving was celebrated on two different days. To end the confusion, Congress passed a law in 1941 establishing the fourth Thursday in November as the federal Thanksgiving Day holiday.
