One of the many things the 2026 BOD will be working on is what role our Club will play in the 100th year celebration of Route 66. Based on what we know and hear it will be a grand celebration.




January 3, 2026, Breakfast will be a Big Biscuit in Owasso, 8529 N. 129th E. Ave.




Wow! It's hard to believe it's already the most wonderful time of the year again! For those out there wondering, I wear a size 1930 or 1931 DeLuxe Phaeton. Ha! With the cooler weather, I've been spending more time inside working on the cars. Our February 1929 Special Coupe is getting very close to completion, and we believe we will show it at the MARC National Meeting in French Lick next year. For those on Facebook, you may have seen the photo below circulating. Of course, this is Bill Sturm with Mike Francis in Sturm's shop. Isn't that a gorgeous 400-A behind them? I'm hoping it will be finished up soon so I can also show it at French Lick.




We've covered a lot of topics over the past year including original luggage racks, dealer literature, firewalls, and factory differences in DeLuxe Roadsters. Speaking of DeLuxe Roadsters, I used the below factory photograph as an example of a 1930 back in April. I still think it's a gorgeous car.

The other day, I was looking through my 1931 Dealer Album. These are the albums that dealers



would keep filled with photographs of the available models so customers could pick out what they wanted. As I was flipping pages, I came across the below photo which is a slight variation on the above version.



**DELUXE ROADSTER** - The DeLuxe Roadster is an unusually attractive type of car for those who seek the advantage of Ford performance in an open car. The specially designed sport top is of tan-colored material and the top bows are of natural wood. Seat cushions are in Bedouin grain tan-colored genuine leather, except the rumble seat and seat back. There is a fender well on the left side front for the spare wheel, a bright metal trunk rack at the rear, cowl lamps and full length bumperson front and rear also are standard equipment. Wheels are in color to harmonize with optional body colors. As with all the other open Ford cars the windshield and windshield wings are of Triplex Shatterproof Glass.

It is very common for the photographs in a Dealer Album to vary from album to album. This is due to the album utilizing small screws to hold the pages in place. It was not bound like a normal book. This allowed Ford to send updates to dealers asking them to remove certain pages in order to insert new ones. All that to say, it is not uncommon to have 1930 photographs in a Dealer Album that contains 1931 information and photographs. However, there is something odd about this particular photo; the radiator shell is clearly a 1931 style. Isn't that interesting? To me, this is just a little more proof that Henry Ford did not waste anything.
