

I would like to welcome new members Clark and Michelle Weins. The Weins are associated with Circle Cinema the oldest cinema in Tulsa,OK.



# Finer Points



Happy New Year! I hope everyone had a great Christmas and that your stockings were filled to the brim with Model "A" parts. I have made some good progress on a 1930 phaeton chassis. I do love the open cars! Recently, I've had the pleasure of driving a couple different 1931 slant windshield cars, and they are really a blast to drive also.

In late 1930, Ford introduced the slanting windshield on the Victoria with much fanfare, and rightfully so! This was a great improvement in design, streamlining, and most importantly safety. Eventually, the ten-degree slanting windshield would be incorporated into the Victoria, the 160 series sedans, the Cabriolets, and the 400-A. To me, these cars are quieter than other Model "A" Fords most likely due to the decreased wind resistance. Below is a clipping from one of my 400-A advertisements.




**SLANTING WINDSHIELD—**  
The windshields of the Victoria, Town Sedan, Standard Sedan, De Luxe Sedan, Cabriolet and Convertible Sedan now slant at an angle of 10 degrees. This adds greatly to beauty, and decreases wind resistance. It also increases the safety and pleasure of night driving, by lessening headlight glare. Windshields of all Ford cars are now made of safety plate glass, minimizing danger in case of accident.

A quieter drive is very nice; however, the biggest advantage is the greatly reduced headlight glare. On a side note, do you want to know what the best kept secret of the Model "A" open car is? Open cars had a slanting windshield for the entire production run! Below is a photo of my 1930 Roadster next to a 1930 Victoria. Do you see how it has the same slope?



Be honest... had you ever noticed the slanting windshield on Roadsters and Phaetons? There's just one small disadvantage that open cars have: no windows! Of course, I don't consider that to be a disadvantage on a 72 degree day!


