MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT BOB STINE



As President, and speaking as well for entire Board, we are excited to offer to you another exciting and eventful year that we hope you will find as enjoyable to participate in as we well.





Finer Points

The cold weather we've had in January has made me wish for slightly warmer weather so I can get the open cars out again! Oh well, more time in the shop working on projects is always a welcome time. Recently, Dad and I have been working on our February 1929 Special Coupe. This has been a fun project, and we are hoping to show it in Fine Point this year at French Lick. Registration is not out yet; however, when it does come out, you all should consider joining us.

Below is a photo of a driver's exterior door handle that I nickel plated for our car. I think it turned out very nice if I do say so myself! Most of the plating in 1929 was nickel.



One small detail that the paint judges look for on cars is whether or not the pin stripe goes behind the handle. At the factory, the cars were striped before the handles and cowl lights were installed. In other words, there were no obstacles in the way of the pin strippers. This is a small detail, but it is important when you plan to show a car. It's also important if you just want your car to be like it was when it came from the factory regardless of if you have a plan to show it.




In case you want to see the passenger side handle, there is a photo below. Lucky for me, this handle is NOS. So, I did not have to do any work on it.
