### Monthly Meeting Minutes

#### July 21, 2026

Secretary John Rinkenbaugh noted that we didn't have a general meeting in June but asked for a motion to accept the May general meeting minutes as published in the Rumble Sheet. Sam Slavens so moved and Tim Bodine seconded the motion, and it passed.

#### New Business:

Mr. Johnson distributed print copies of his questions and made a motion that these questions be addressed and answered at the September General Membership meeting.

President Stine resigned his office and he and Board member Linda Stine left the meeting. Mr. Johnson accepted a second to his motion. Mr. Johnson called for a vote which passed with a single nay as being redundant because this whole issue will need a Club majority vote to proceed with a bylaws revision to include MARC along with our MAFCA Chapter.

The meeting then proceeded to the evening's program by Master Magician Roger Cornelison who proceeded to entertain the Club with a delightful magic show. Following tricks with balls and cups, ropes, flowers, a mysterious candle, a vanishing catsup bottle, cards and a goblet of disappearing ink, the Club thanked Roger with multiple rounds of applause.

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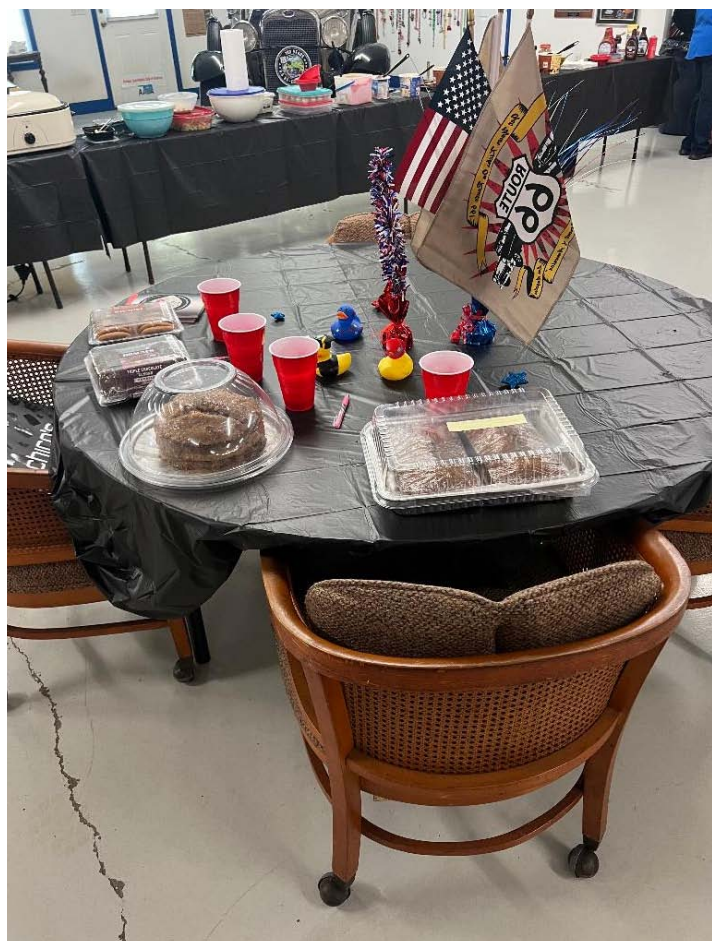

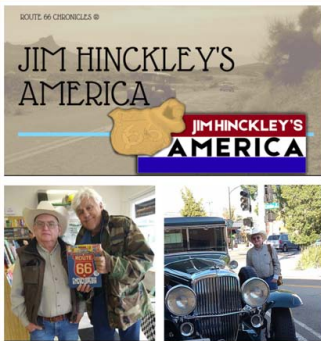

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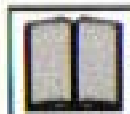
